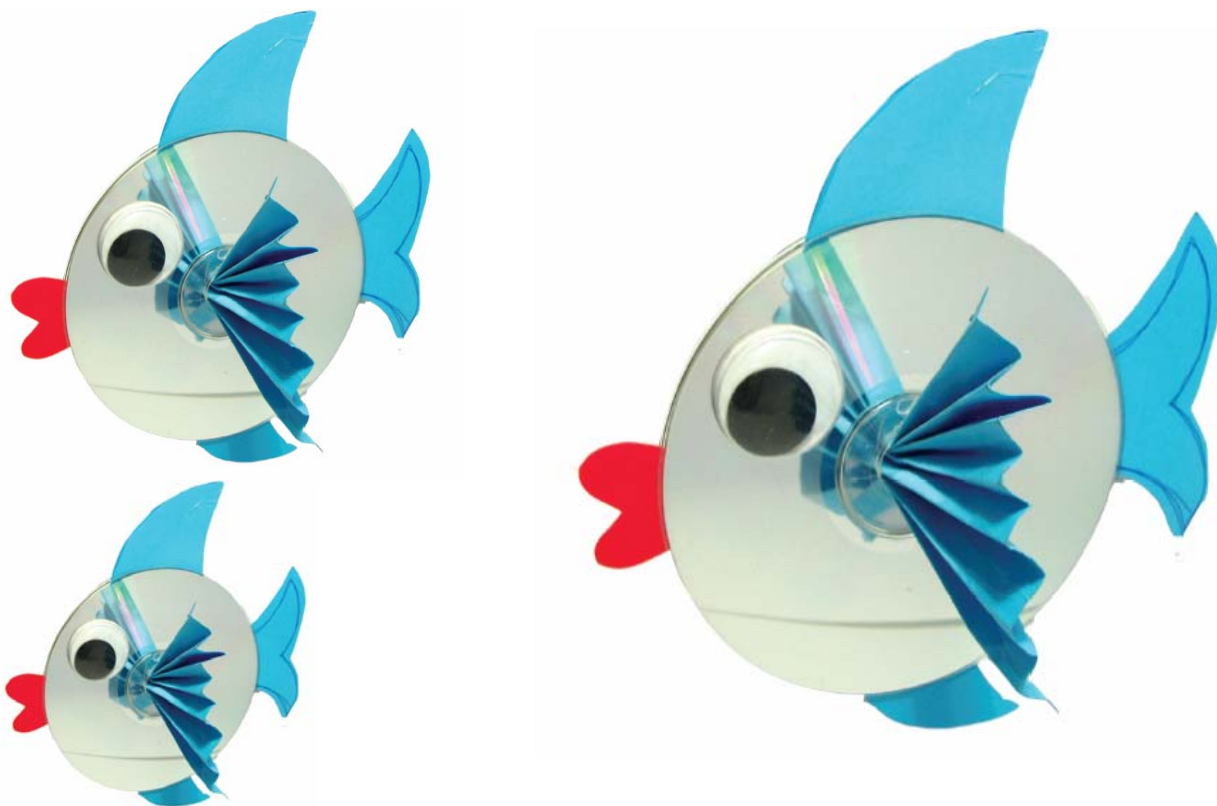


# CD FISH

You don't have to use the materials listed to make your fish. CDs can be substituted for mount board, which is a stiffer type of card. Using the mount board instead of a CD also means that you can make your fish any shape you wish. The fish's eyes can also be any material you wish, not just the google eyes. Buttons are just as effective. You can substitute yarn or wool for the fishing line if you wish to hang your fish up. You can use a hot glue gun to stick materials to the c.d. s, but P.V.A. glue will also be effective.



## Materials:

2 CDs, coloured paper trips, google eyes, fishing line, glue.

## Method:

Suggested Instructions:

1. Hot glue the fishing line to the printed side of one of the c.d. s
2. While you glue dries draw/cut out your fish's features (lips, fins and tails) from the coloured paper.
3. Hot glue gun the edges of these to the printed side of your c.d. Make sure that they are stuck flat.
4. Stick the printed sides of the c.d. s together.
5. Glue on google eyes.
