



MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS



Bongo Drums

Materials: Cardboard Cylinder (to suit drum size), cardboard, buttons/beads - pins for holding on the "skin", paint, glue.

Method:

1. Trace around onto your cardboard the outside end of the cylinder but do not cut out. 2. Paint the cylinder. 3. Using the circle as a guide, draw star points all around it. Now cut out. Make sure you have enough buttons/beads to cover each point. This is your drum "skin" 4. Glue the skin to the top of the cylinder, making sure you have glued down each point on the side of the cylinder. 5. Glue buttons on at the base of each point along the side of the cylinder

Music sticks

Materials: 1 Cylinder, 2 plastic container lids - these are the ends so make sure they fit around the cylinder ends, Small plastic beads/ dry pasta etc – for sound, Glitter, Paint, Glue.

Method:

1. Paint or decorate cylinder and container lids. If you are adding glitter, leave this until the very end. 2. Glue one container lid onto the end of the cylinder. Make sure it is stuck securely. 3. Fill cylinder with sound makers – beads, pasta, rice etc. 4. Glue and secure the other lid onto the other end of the cylinder. 5. Add some glitter if you wish.
