



# FROG

**Materials:** 3 small corks, film canister, paint cardboard/material, beads/buttons, glue

**Method:**

1. Glue whole small corks onto the sides of the film canister. These are the legs.
2. Take another small cork and cut it into quarters. Stick two of these onto the front of the film canister. These are the frog's arms.
3. Cut the frog's feet and hands (feet will be larger) and the backing for the frog's eyes.
4. Paint your frog.
5. Glue on feet and arm bases to the bottom of the corks.
6. Glue eye backing on approximately half a cm down from the top of the film canister.
7. Glue on bead/button eyes. You can also use google eyes for this if you wish.

# ELEPHANT

**Materials:** Cardboard cylinder, scrap material (canvas), 4 corks, google eyes, paint, glue

**Method:**

1. On the canvas, cut out two ear shapes for your elephant. Put these aside.
2. On the canvas, trace around outside end of cylinder to make two circles. These will be glued onto each end to make the body of the elephant.
3. Glue ears to one side of a canvas circle.
4. Now glue canvas circles to either end of the cylinder.
5. Take corks and glue onto the underside of the elephant's body, making sure it is stable enough to stand freely.
6. Cut a thin short strip of material to stick on the rear of the elephant body as a tail. Cut another strip that is longer and a touch wider for the trunk.
7. Glue the both of these onto the body of the elephant.
8. Once the glue has dried, paint and add detail to your elephant, including the eyes..
