## ALIEN -

How you make an alien is only limited to your imagination!

### **Materials:**

1 Big Lid, 1 Small Cork, 1 Big Cork, Film Strips, 4 Metal Bottle Tops, 1 Iridescent Chenille Stick, Paint, Textas, Glue

### **Method:**

1. Paint your lid, corks and bottle tops. Leave to dry. 2. When dry, hot glue the metal bottle top feet to the base of the lid. 3. We stuck film strips on the top of the lid, glued the small cork on top, adding the larger cork on top of that again to make the alien's "head". 4. Cut your chenille sticks according to how long you want your alien's antenna to be. Glue these to the top of the large cork. 5. Use a textas to add alien's "features".

## ROCKET SHIP - Start with these directions then let your imagination fly!

### **Materials:**

1 Cardboard Cone, Foam Core, Coloured Paper, Deodorant can lid, Glitter Glue, Glue, Star Scatters.

### **Method:**

1. Cover cone with red paper, gluing it into place. Allow to dry. 2. Cut three shark fin shapes out of the foam core. Paint or cover with paper. 3. Glue the fins around the base of the cone. 4. Place the deodorant can lid over the top of the cone, making sure it fits snugly. You shouldn't need to use glue to stick it down, but can use some P.V.A. to secure it if you need to. If you want to decorate this you can. We used silver glitter glue. 5. Decorate your rocket. We stuck on star scatters, but you could cut out and stick on paper shapes, add material etc.
