



TURTLE

Materials: Star Cardboard Cylinders (2-3" high), Cardboard Sheet, Paint, Google Eyes, Glue.

Method:

1. Trace two templates around the outside of the cylinder onto the cardboard and cut out. These will be the top and bottom of the turtle's body, so make sure they will fit adequately across the gaps.
2. Hot glue gun these pieces to the top and bottom of the cylinder.
3. Cut out a head, 4 legs and a tail from the cardboard. These will be stuck on the base of the turtle, so make sure that they have a little extra length on them.
4. Position the head, legs and tail and glue into place.
5. Glue on eyes. We used google eyes for our turtle, but buttons or even paper will also look effective.
6. Paint or decorate your turtle. Our turtle is green and yellow, but you can paint him any colour you like! If you don't want to use paint you can decorate the turtle with paper scraps, material, wool or just colour him in.
